





- While the car is ON, hold the handheld garage door transmitter 1-3 inches from the HomeLink® button you want to program in the vehicle.
- Push and hold both the HomeLink* button being programmed and the button on the garage door transmitter.

TO **ERASE** ALL SET CHANNELS:

Push and hold the two outside HomeLink® buttons for 20 seconds until the orange indicator flashes. An individual channel cannot be erased.



ROLLING OR NON-ROLLING?

Check your garage door opener motor in your garage for a "LEARN" or "TRAIN" button by the hanging antenna. If you have one of these, you have a Rolling Code garage door opener.

For Non-Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go constant.

For Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go from a slow blink to blinking rapidly.

- For Rolling Code garage door openers only, firmly push and release the "LEARN" or "TRAIN" button on your garage door opener motor in your garage, then push the HomeLink® button in your vehicle for two long presses.
- If the programming was successful, your garage door should open and close with your chosen HomeLink® button.

- 1) Press "Apps" on the touchscreen.

- There are two ways to activate: via email or via an agent. On the next page, you can either enter your name and email, or press "Call An Agent" to directly speak with someone.

TIP:

You can use your remote commands from the Uconnect App, your Owner's Site account, or by calling an agent.

However, not all remote commands will work when calling the agent.



Pair a Phone



1

Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your mobile device.

2

With the vehicle in the ACC or ON/RUN position, press the Phone button in the vehicle's touchscreen menu bar.

3

Press "Pairing" and then press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".

4

Select "Add Device" then follow the prompts on your phone and in the touchscreen.

KEEP IN MIND

Some mobile phones will require you to enter a PIN as part of the connection process.

Ready to remove a phone or audio device?



- (1) Press the "Pairing" button on the touchscreen.
- (2) Press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".
- (3) Press "Settings" next to the phone or device you want to remove.
- (4) Press "Delete Device".
- (5) Press "X" to exit the settings screen. The device should be removed.

YOU MAY ALSO BE ABLE TO CONNECT YOUR APPS

If your vehicle is equipped with Android Auto™ & Apple CarPlay®, connect your unlocked smartphone to one of the media USB ports in your vehicle.

Once connected and recognized, the AndroidTM or CarPlay[®] icon will replace the phone icon on your personalized menu bar.

KEEP IN MINIO



For Android™ Users, if the Android Auto™ app was not previously downloaded, it will download the first time you plug in your device.



For Apple Users, Apple CarPlay is only compatible with iPhone5 or later and requires Siri being enabled in Settings.

4x4 Operation

FIVE-POSITION TRANSFER CASE

2WD HIGH

Used for normal street and highway driving.

4WD HIGH AUTO

Sends power to the front wheels.

4WD HIGH PT

Forces the front and rear wheels to rotate at the same speed.

NEUTRAL

Used for flat towing behind another vehicle.

AWD LOW

Provides low speed four-wheel drive. Forces the front and rear wheels to rotate at the same speed.

If your vehicle is equipped with a four-position transfer case, see "Four-Wheel Drive Operation" in your Owner's Manual.



AXLE LOCK


To unlock the axles, push the axle lock OFF button.

TIP:

When the rear axle is locked, pushing the switch down again will lock or unlock the front axle.

OFF ROAD+

When activated, the vehicle's performance will improve depending on which 4WD mode is activated.



AXLE LOCK SWITCH

Push the switch up to lock the front axle & rear axle.

Push the switch down to lock the rear axle only.

SWAY BAR DISCONNECT

Shift to either 4WD High or 4WD Low and push the SWAY BAR button.

If your vehicle is equipped with Tru-Lok, see "Four-Wheel Drive Operation" in your Owner's Manual.

KEEP IN MIND

Sway Bar Disconnect should be off during normal driving conditions.
